5 TIPS TO KEEP YOUR PETS SAFE THIS HALLOWEEN

Costumes and candy make Halloween a highly anticipated event for children and adults alike, but the holiday can be particularly spooky for pets. Some of the same things that bring humans joy on All Hallows Eve can lead to poisoning, stress or anxiety, which may cause four-legged family members to run away or react aggressively.

To help ensure Halloween is fun for every member of the family, take note of these safety tips

from the experts at VCA Animal Hospitals, which has more than 1,000 locations across North America that cared for more than 4.5 million pets last year. Talk to your veterinarian if you need assistance dealing with pet anxiety.

Create a safe space for your pet at home. If your neighborhood is particularly busy on Halloween and the sidewalks are overflowing with exuberant trick-or-treaters, it may be best to leave your pet at home. Pets can be thrown off by extra people on the street or at the door in frightening costumes, which could lead to uncommon reactions such as growling or biting if they feel threatened. Even if your pets are mellow and enjoy greeting guests, consider keeping them inside as you sit by yourself near the door or

outside to greet trick-or-treaters as they knock or ring the doorbell. Otherwise, consider keeping your pet in a room away from the frenzy with a TV, radio or white noise machine to dull the sounds.

Be cautious when taking your pet trick-or-treating. If you do decide to venture out with your pet, make sure he or she is always close to you on a secure leash (avoid retractable leashes). Observe your surroundings and assess people – especially friendly, excited children – approaching you and your pet, because physical contact from strangers in costumes may instigate a fearful or aggressive reaction.

Consider skipping the costume. It's best not to dress up your pets for Halloween, but if you choose to, it's important for pets to wear safe, comfortable costumes. They should be loose enough to provide freedom of movement but not loose enough to be a tripping hazard. On the other hand, costumes that are too tight can restrict breathing and make movement difficult. Make sure your pet's costume does not interfere with vision or hearing. Also beware of small parts, like buttons or loose strings, that could be chewed off and swallowed.

Keep treats away from pets. Resist the



temptation to share Halloween candy with your pet. In fact, keep all candy safely out of reach. Chocolate, candy or gum artificially sweetened with xylitol can be dangerous for dogs. Plus, cellophane or foil wrappers can cause problems if swallowed. Even natural treats like caramel apples should be off limits as eating items not normally on the menu can cause upset stomachs, GI blockages or pancreatitis.

Decorate with safety in mind. Festive decorations help set the mood, but they can also create health risks for your pet.

While non-toxic, pumpkin and pumpkin seeds can upset stomachs, especially when consumed in large quantities. Lit candles in Jack-O-Lanterns may pose fire hazards if toppled by a curious four-legged friend. Decorative lights can brighten your porch but should be kept out of your pet's reach as nibbling on electrical cords can cause electrocution.

BOWERS MUSEUM CELEBRATES DÍA DE LOS MUERTOS WITH FREE FESTIVAL AND COMMUNITY OFRENDA

Bowers Museum invites the community to gather in celebration of life, memory, and tradition during its annual Día de los Muertos (Day of the Dead) Festival and Community Memorial Altar (Ofrenda). This heartfelt celebration honors loved ones—family, friends, and even cherished pets—who continue to live on in spirit through the joy and beauty they brought to our lives.

Visitors are invited to bring a photo of a loved one or pet to place on Bowers Museum's beautifully adorned community ofrendas, located in the Historic Courtyard Annex and open during regular museum hours, Tuesday through Sunday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., now through November 7. These altars, filled with color, music, and offerings, provide a meaningful space for remembrance and reflection.

The museum's free Día de los Muertos Festival will take place Sunday, November 2, from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., featuring a vibrant lineup of cultural performances by Mariachi Anacatlán, Relámpago del Cielo, Los Cuates, Xipe Totec, and Joel Aceves. SPOOKY SEASON SNACKS POP UP SCARY SWEET HALLOWEEN TREATS

Scaring up a good time this Halloween starts with spooky costumes, ghoulish decor and treats you can share with your favorite ghosts and goblins. For an extra haunting twist, skip the store-bought candies and break out your cauldron for tempting homemade sweets.

You can celebrate the seed-to-snack simplicity of one of fall's favorite snacks – popcorn – with crunchy desserts that pair perfectly with your favorite spooky traditions. Popcorn's smell, taste and versatility help it enhance Halloween as a budget-friendly solution for ghostly gatherings.

Embrace the taste of autumn – pumpkin spice – with a snack that allows you to indulge throughout the season. These White Chocolate and Pumpkin Pie Spice Popcorn Bites offer warm flavor without the scare. Simply pour melted pumpkin pie spice-seasoned chocolate over popped popcorn, toss with toffee bits and sea salt then break into bite-sized chunks for a seasonal sweet that's perfect for celebrating National Popcorn Poppin' Month.

Go for a Ghoulish Snack Bar
Encourage a little devious creativity this Halloween with a popcorn bar (char-boo-terrie board) that features everyone's favorites. Start with enough freshly popped popcorn to feed all your little zombies and vampires then add

seasonal favorites like candy corn, chocolate candies, individually wrapped treats, dried fruit, nuts and beyond.

To pop popcorn on a stovetop, cover the bottom of a 3- to 4-quart pan with a thin layer of vegetable oil (don't use butter, it will burn). Place 3 kernels of popcorn in the pan, cover with a loose lid that allows steam to escape and heat. When the kernels pop, pour in enough popcorn to cover the bottom of the pan, one kernel deep, then cover the pan and shake to evenly spread the oil. When the popping begins to slow to a few seconds apart, remove the pan from the stovetop. The heated oil will still pop the remaining kernels.

White Chocolate and Pumpkin Pie Spice Popcorn Bites

- Servings: 12
- 12 cups unsalted, unbuttered popped popcorn
 - 3 cups chopped white chocolate or white chocolate chips
 - 1 tablespoon light olive oil
 - 2 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice
 - 1/2 cup toffee bits
 - 1 teaspoon flaked sea salt, crushed

Line large, rimmed baking sheet with parchment paper or wax paper. Place popcorn in large mixing bowl.

In microwave-safe bowl, combine white chocolate, olive oil and pumpkin pie spice; microwave on medium 2-3 minutes, or until melted and smooth,



stirring after each minute.

Pour melted white chocolate mixture over popcorn; add toffee bits and toss to combine. Transfer to prepared baking sheet, spreading to edges of pan; sprinkle sea salt over top.

Let cool; refrigerate 1-2 hours, or until set. Break into chunks for serving.

Tip: Homemade pumpkin pie spice can be made by combining 3 parts ground cinnamon with 1 part ground nutmeg, 1 part allspice and 1 part ginger.

MAGNIFICENT MANSION OF DRACULA ACTOR BELA LUGOSI LISTED FOR \$7.5 MILLION



For the first time in over 50 years, Villa Dorada, one of Old Hollywood's most historic, preserved, and interesting mansions, is on the market, listed at \$7.5 million. The 1929 Spanish Revival estate with a roster of celebrity owners and residents, including Bela Lugosi, the original movie Dracula; Oscar-winning songwriter Jimmy Van Heusen; and '70s fab actress Yvette Mimieux, is located just above Brad Pitt's newly purchased home in the historic Outpost Estates and among celebrity neighbors Charlize Theron, Orlando Bloom and Winona Ryder.

The estate, which was built in 1929, is an architectural jewel boasting approximately 7,400 square feet, multiple levels, and sweeping views that stretch from the Hollywood Sign to Downtown Los Angeles and the Pacific Ocean. Its original design features, which have been meticulously preserved, include pristine magnesite floors, a rare wood-

paneled elevator, an original intercom system, hand-carved wooden doors, vintage tilework, and distinctive Art Deco brass doorknobs.

The property features four spacious ensuite bedrooms in the main residence, plus an expansive two-bedroom staff quarters. Entertainment spaces include a step-down parlor with a built-in bar and a lower-level ballroom anchored by an oversized fireplace that opens directly to the backyard and a covered patio for al fresco dining. Set on a rare, flat cul-de-sac of just 14 homes, its unique location in the coveted Outpost Estates neighborhood, which restricts tour buses, ensures a level of privacy fitting for a legendary residence.

In a city constantly rebuilding and modernizing, Villa Dorada stands as a tangible link to the golden age of Los Angeles and the personalities who shaped it.

The home is listed with Tom Davila,

HALLOWEEN IS HERE! HOW TO CELEBRATE IN A SAFE AND FUN WAY

Every year, you count down the days until Halloween. You love selecting costumes for your whole family, indulging in all your favorite treats and celebrating with friends. But this year is different - while you long to celebrate the holiday to the fullest, you also want to make choices to keep your family and your community safe. Like many Halloween enthusiasts, rather than forgoing beloved traditions altogether, you are coming up with creative, out-of-the-box ways to celebrate safely and keep everyone healthy this season, but you still need some guidance.

The Halloween and Costume Association, The Hershey Company and other partner organizations have joined forces to provide guidance on how best to celebrate Halloween safely this year. The Halloween Safety guidelines - available on Halloween2020.org - are consistent with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Holiday Celebrations Guidelines and include a color-coded COVID risk level map, provided by the Harvard Global Health

Institute.

"Families and policy-makers need clear and consistent information when it comes to COVID-19 risks to inform decision-making, including how to participate safely in the upcoming Halloween holiday and trick-or-treating activities associated with it," said Dr. Ingrid Katz, Infectious Diseases Expert, and Associate Faculty Director at the Harvard Global Health Institute. "Through our interactive COVID risk level map, we hope to provide parents a reliable source to help them celebrate the Halloween holiday in the most safe, fun way possible according to the risk level in their community."

With most of the country in the moderate risk category, it's likely that many communities and families will find new ways to celebrate this year, including neighborhood trick-or-treat drive-ups, reverse trick-or-treating and neighborhood or backyard candy hunts. These creative celebration ideas allow for fun and safety to remain a top priority.

"Halloween is more important than ever this year as we navigate the new normal together and are seeking opportunities to celebrate safely. We're inspired by the public-private partnerships and groups coming together that all have a shared value of celebrating Halloween safely," says Chuck Raup, president, U.S., The Hershey Company.

The takeaway: There are many fun and

safe ways to celebrate this Halloween season, from carving pumpkins to having Halloween-themed movie nights with your favorite Halloween treats like Hershey's, Reese's and Kit Kat.

Here are some tips and ideas for celebrating safely based on your risk zone color:

Yellow zones

Focus on trick-or-treat safety. A Halloween neighborhood parade is a good option for yellow zones. Organize a neighborhood costume parade where the route is predetermined and marked to maintain safe distances between participants. Stay safe by incorporating sanitization stations, yellow caution tape, 6-foot sidewalk stickers/tape and age group signs. Or, do the reverse and have kids decked out in their costumes in the front yard as neighbors walk or drive by and deliver candy from a safe distance.

Orange zones

For orange-zone communities, let the treats come to you. Trick-or-treat in reverse by having kids wear their costumes in the front yard as neighbors walk or drive by and deliver candy. Another option is a trick-or-treat drive-by where you wear costumes and then drive to visit friends and family in costume and deliver some treats! Honk, text or shout upon arrival and deliver some treats or tricks in costume to your favorite folks!

Red zones

At-home celebrations are safest for red



zones. Consider planning a Halloween movie night or a virtual costume party. You can also make this a special time with a scavenger hunt throughout your home. Create different themed rooms throughout the house and send the kids on a scavenger hunt for fun swag. Hide candy, toys and prizes or even make some gift certificates to stay up late, choose the movie or eat an extra piece of candy. Keep the big kids engaged with trickier clues and fun age-appropriate rewards.

Even with the extra precautions and adjustments needed to ensure a safe celebration, Halloween 2020 still promises to be a once-in-a-lifetime experience. In fact, a Halloween such as this won't happen again for at least another 152 years. Not only does Halloween 2020 fall on a Saturday, it also happens to be a full moon and daylight saving time. Additionally, the day occurs during a blue moon this year, the second full moon of October.

DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME ENDS THIS SUNDAY

When does the time change for Fall 2025? That time change question seems to be something that a lot of people are asking themselves. For this year, 2025, the time change will occur on Sunday, November 2, 2025 at 2 a.m. Eastern Standard Time. And remember for the time change 2025 this fall you will “fall back”, or move your clocks back one hour and gain some much needed sleep.

It is easy to remember which way to move your clocks if you follow the old adage of, in the spring you “Spring forward” and in the fall you “Fall back”. It is nice during the time change for fall 2025 that you get to gain an hour of sleep. According to many studies most of us don’t sleep enough, so this extra hour will be welcomed.

Remember that the way this whole time change thing is setup is as follows: At 2 a.m. on the second Sunday in March each year, we set our clocks forward one hour ahead of Standard Time (“Spring forward”). Then at 2 a.m. on the first Sunday in November each year we “Fall back” and we set our clocks back one hour and this returns us to Standard Time.

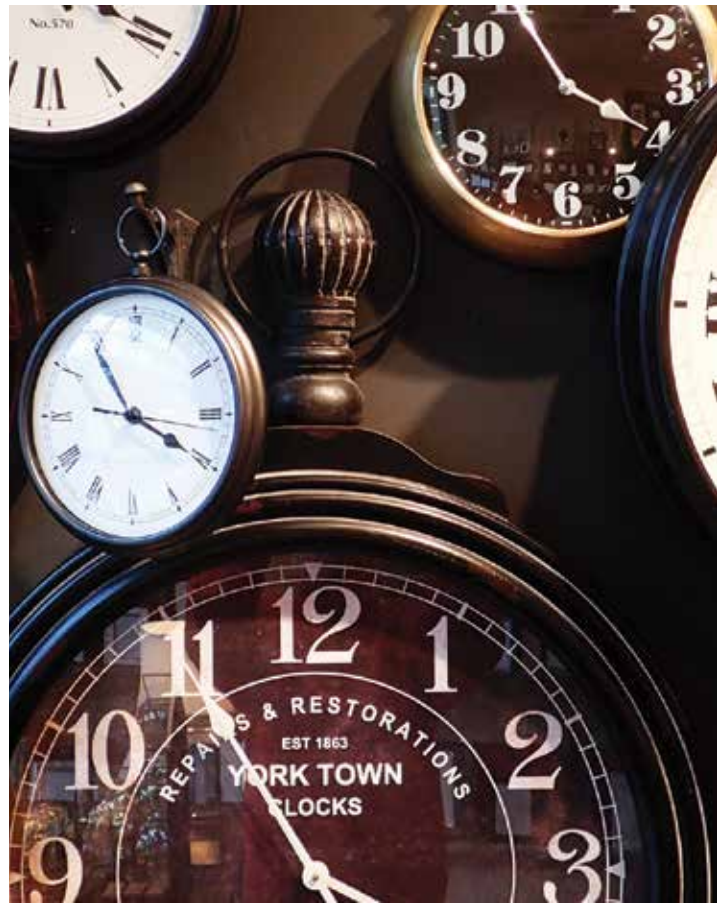
Daylight Saving Time was actually put in place during World War I in the United States as a way to save energy for the

war production. By changing the time it made for longer days between April and October. Then again during World War II the government required the states to perform the instituted time change. But then after the wars the states were free to choose whether or not they wanted to institute the Daylight Savings time or not.

But by 1966, Congress got involved and passed the Uniform Time Act, which then dictated the length of Daylight Saving Time. These longer days do mean that we use less energy as a country in lighting our homes and businesses.

In 2005, Congress came along again and passed the Energy Policy Act. That started that starting in 2007 that Daylight Saving Time would be four weeks longer. The thought process was that we would be able to save approximately 10,000 barrels of oil each day through reducing power requirements of businesses. But that is a very difficult metric to verify and to know if we are seeing the savings that was projected.

So, when does the time change for fall 2025? Just remember that on Sunday, November 2, 2025 at 2 a.m. Eastern Standard Time you will set your clocks back one hour. Enjoy your extra hour of sleep!

Taste of Wine & Food

JUSTIN WINE DINNER AT VITTORIO'S AND GIVING BACK AT UTR STORYBOOK BALL

Founded in 1981 by former international banker Justin Baldwin, JUSTIN Vineyards & Winery, helped transform Paso Robles from a quiet ranching region into one of California's premier wine destinations. Baldwin's vision was simple yet bold: craft Bordeaux-style blends that could stand beside the great wines of the world. He planted Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, and Merlot on limestone-rich hillsides west of Paso Robles, where warm days and cool nights nurtured both elegance and structure. His flagship Isosceles blend soon became a benchmark, earning 90-plus scores and inspiring a generation of Central Coast vintners.

Today the winery's legacy continues under the craftsmanship of Winemaker Scott Shirley, who came to Justin after thirteen vintages at Napa Valley's Opus One. Combining a scientific background with an artist's touch, Shirley approaches each harvest like a painter facing a blank canvas, seeking balance, texture, and depth in every wine he creates.

That vision came to life at the Justin Wine Dinner at Vittorio's Italian Trattoria in Carmel Valley. The evening was narrated by Southern Glazer's Wine and Spirits, David Sheline, Sales Consultant and Certified Sommelier, and Eric Brehn, Division Manager. The evening showcased one of Paso Robles' most recognized wineries through a multi-course pairing prepared by Executive Chef Angelo Gijon.

Guests began with the 2023 Justin Sauvignon Blanc, a clean, textured white showing bright citrus and tropical fruit with a hint of fresh herbs. Its crisp mineral structure offered a refreshing prelude to the courses ahead.

The grilled peach and burrata salad paired beautifully with Justin Chardonnay 2023, medium-bodied and layered with pineapple, pear, and lemon curd followed by subtle tarragon and fennel. A touch of new oak and malolactic fermentation added a creamy texture that echoed the burrata's richness.

A highlight of the evening was braised short-rib pappardelle in San Marzano tomato ragu topped with Parmigiano-Reggiano. Paired with the 2022 Justin Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, aged 18 months in French oak (60 percent new), the wine's ripe black-fruit core, sweet spice, and classic herbal notes mirrored the layered richness of the short rib for a seamless match.

The grilled New York strip steak with rosemary-garlic potatoes and wild mushroom Marsala reduction followed, complemented by Justin Isosceles 2021,

the winery's signature Bordeaux-style blend. Aromas of black currant, cherry, cedar, and spice led to a full-bodied palate of cassis, vanilla, and tobacco leaf. Its long, balanced finish elevated Chef Gijon's earthy Marsala sauce.

Dessert, a decadent brownie cake with vanilla-cream sauce, closed the evening perfectly. A few saved sips of Isosceles alongside the chocolate dolce delivered a fitting finale to a memorable dinner.

A few weeks later the spotlight shifted from Paso Robles elegance to heartfelt generosity to celebrate connection and giving at the United Through Reading Storybook Ball.

United Through Reading's Storybook Ball

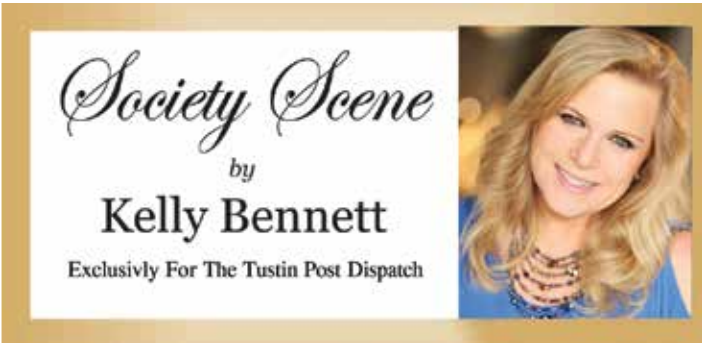
In a competitive industry where

RED CROSS REMINDER: CHECK SMOKE ALARMS WHEN TURNING CLOCKS BACK

Daylight Saving Time ends this weekend and when everyone turns their clocks back, the American Red Cross reminds them to also take these steps to make sure their household is prepared for emergencies.

"It's important for everyone to make sure their household is ready," said Tony Briggs, Communications Director, American Red Cross Desert to the Sea Region. "A disaster like a home fire can happen anywhere, at any time. We urge people to take these steps now and know what they should do if an emergency occurs."

Check smoke alarm batteries. When turning the clocks ahead, take a few minutes to replace the smoke alarm batteries and push the test button to make sure the alarms are working. It's also a great time to check carbon monoxide detectors.

Install smoke alarms. If someone doesn't have smoke alarms, install them. At a minimum, put one on every level of the home, inside bedrooms and outside sleeping areas. Check local building codes for additional requirements.

Practice an escape plan. Make sure everyone in the family knows how to get out of every room and how to get out of the home in less than two minutes.

Get a kit. Keep disaster supplies in an

easy-to-carry bag to use at home or carry in case ordered to evacuate.

Make a plan. Have all household members plan what steps they should take if an emergency occurs.

Be informed. Learn what emergencies can occur in the area and how officials notify residents should a disaster occur.

RED CROSS APPS People can download the all-inclusive Red Cross Emergency app which combines more than 35 emergency alerts to help keep the user safe. And there is a special mobile app - Monster Guard - designed for kids, teaching them to prepare for emergencies at home by playing an engaging game. Users can find the apps in smartphone app stores by searching for the American Red Cross or going to redcross.org/apps.

HOME FIRE CAMPAIGN Seven times a day someone in this country dies in a fire. The Red Cross has been working to reduce that number through its Home Fire Campaign, a multi-year effort to reduce the number of home fire deaths and injuries by 25 percent. Launched in October of 2014, the Red Cross and thousands of campaign partners have installed more than one million smoke alarms nationally. Here in the Desert to the Sea region, the Red Cross has installed more than 12,000 smoke



alarms in Orange, Riverside, and San Bernardino Counties.

WHAT PEOPLE CAN DO People can visit redcross.org/homefires to find out more about how to protect themselves and their loved homes from fire. They can become a Red Cross volunteer by going to redcross.org/volunteer. They can also help by donating to Red Cross Disaster Relief by visiting redcross.org, calling 1-800-RED CROSS or texting the word REDCROSS to 90999 to make a \$10 donation. Donations to Disaster Relief will be used to prepare for, respond to and help people recover


